strength. Manufacturer of backboard shall have over ten years of experience producing such item. Backboard shall meet NCAA and high school requirements. corners. The lower horizontal frame section shall have a tubular steel support brace for added former and fastened together and connected with heavy gauge steel mounting plates to reinforce The LXP4200 backboard shall be fabricated with steel frame constructed of formed steel angles,

cushioning pad shall be used between steel mounting plate and glass to protect board against possible breakage. Entire frame and components shall be powder coated with a durable neutral gray finish. Acrylic

Glass shall be ½" in thickness and fully tempered with white target lines permanently fused onto the surface. 12mm glass will not be considered equal to ½" glass, with a nominal thickness range of .485" to .515", and will not be used as a substitute for full ½" glass. Vinyl shock absorbing material insulates the glass from the frame. Goal mounting holes shall be on standard 5" horizontal and 4" vertical centers.
